

Needle Systems

130/705 H

Home sewing machines require a flat shank needle with a scarf. All needles in this system have a scarf and flattened shank for perfect positioning in the needle bar in relation to the book.

15x1 H

Cross reference to 130/705 H.

Needle Selection

Choose needle size according to thread thickness and needle type according to fabric application.

Feature: Medium ball point, special eye and scarf.

 Fabric Use: Elastic materials and highly elastic knitwear.
 The medium ball point, specially designed eye and scarf prevent skipped

stitches.



Sewing with a Specialty Thread

A needle with a larger eye produces less friction on the thread as it passes through the eye. Try an Embroidery, Gold Embroidery, Metallic or Topstitch needle.



resists adhesives, improves needle wear and penetration of coarse and densely woven fabrics.



NEEDLE ANATOMY




Point and Tip: Length, shape and size vary according to needle types.

Eye: The hole through which thread passes. The shape and size vary according to needle type.

Scarf: Indentation above the eye that allows the bobbin hook to smoothly grab the thread under the throat plate to create a stitch.

NEEDLE ANATOMY



Groove: Cradles and guides thread to the eye.


Blade: Needle size is determined by the blade diameter (i.e., size 75 is 75mm)


Shoulder: Sloping area transitioning between the shank and blade.

Shank: Household needles have a flat shank.

Butt: Beveled end.







ELx705 SERGER (OVERLOCK)



• **Size**: 80/12, 90/14,

Assorted

· Color Code: Black

 Feature: Designed for use in electronic multi-purpose sergers that do overlock stitches. Not suitable for use in home sewing machines or embroidery machines. Machines should specify ELx705.

HIGH SPEED PROFESSIONAL QUILTING

- **Size**: 75/11, 90/14, 100/16
- Feature: A chromeplated, flat shank needle (similar to 130/705 H) designed specifically for high-speed professional quilting machines (i.e., Janome 1600 P Series). This needle features a short shank and a slightly rounded needle point with a shank diameter of only 2 mm.



• Fabric Use: Suitable for all common materials — jersey, denim, fancy fabrics, fake fur, etc.

- **Size**: 70/10, 80/12, 90/14, 100/16
- Feature: Designed for use when sewing with embroidery stabilizer, temporary spray adhesive, or self-adhesive hook and loop tape. Anti-adhesive coating (NIT), extra large eye, distinctive scarf, and reinforced blade prevent skipped stitches and provides a residue-free needle.

Twin & Triple Needles

Twin Needles are available for most fabrics. Twin Needle properties are equivalent to single needles. Use for pintucks, topstitching, single and multi-colored decorative seams and hems.

EMBROIDERY TWIN



- Size: 2.0/75, 3.0/75
- Feature: Two Embroidery needles mounted on one shank create two rows of stitches simultaneously.
- Fabric Use: Use with rayon, polyester, and other specialty embroidery threads.

Decorative Stitches

Hemstitch — Hemstitch 110/18, 120/19 or Dbl. Hemstitch 100

Pintucks — Twin 60-100, NE 1.6-4.0

Twin Stitches — Choose needle type 70-100, NE 1.6-8.0

Triple Stitches — 2.5/80, 3.0/80

METALLIC TWIN



- Size: 2.5/80, 3.0/90
- Feature: Two Metallic needles mounted on one shank create two rows of stitches simultaneously.
- Fabric Use: Special effect and fancy threads, particularly for metallic threads

Definitions

NE — Distance between needles NM — Needle size 130/705 H — Household needle with flat shank and scarf, equivalent to 15x1 H (Japanese) and 2020 (Singer).

- Feature: A Wing needle and a Universal needle with a 2.5 mm separation combined on a single shank for decorative stitching in dual rows.
- Fabric Use: Light or medium weight loosely woven fabrics; for heirloom sewing and decorative cutwork.

Serger/Overlock/Specialty Machines

UNIVERSAL TWIN

- Size: 1.6/70, 1.6/80, 2.0/80, 2.5/80, 3.0/90, 4.0/80, 4.0/90, 4.0/100, Assorted
- Feature: Two Universal needles mounted on one shank create two rows of stitches simultaneously.
- Fabric Use: Numerous wovens and knits.



Replace Your Needle

The rule of thumb is to change the needle after every eight (8) hours of sewing or after each sewing project.

Changing the needle is the easiest way to improve stitch quality!

UNIVERSAL TWIN — WIDE



- Size: 6.0/100, 8.0/100
- Feature: Two Universal needles mounted on one shank create two rows of stitches simultaneously.
- Fabric Use: Numerous wovens and knits.

Change Your Needle!

Worn or damaged needles result in:

- Broken or shredded threads
- Skipped or uneven stitches
- Puckered or damaged fabrics
- Popping sound made by sewing machine

CHANGE YOUR NEEDLE!



Dull or Worn Needles result in:

- Damaged or broken threads
 - Skipped stitches
- Puckered or damaged fabrics
 - Uneven seams ●
 - Popping or clunking sound
