

## Whitlock's Weekly Whimsy <u>Week 2</u>

## Block 11

## **Cutting:**

Fabric	Measurements
Color 1	4 @ 2 x 2
	2 @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cut diagonally
Color 7	1 @ 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> x 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub>
Color 8	4 @ 2 x 2
Color 12	4 @ 2 x 2

## Sewing:

Let's revisit Square in a Square! Theses blocks will be an a couple other blocks so we will practice them again. Lay out your block as shown.





We will begin by making our center square. First find the center of your Color 7 block. I usually fold in half and finger press. This time I used an iron-off pen to mark it so that it would be easier to see in the photos. Place your first triangle even with the top of the square and the point on the line. Sew.

Repeat for the bottom triangle. When both are sewn, take it to your pressing station and press towards the triangles.



Cut off the "dog ears". Refold or mark your center and repeat with both side triangles. Trim to 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>









Next we will make the "twosie" blocks. Match up your Color 1 and Color 12  $2 \ge 2 \ge 2$  squares and sew them together. They will measure  $2 \ge 3 \frac{1}{2}$ . Make 4

At this point lay out all your sections again to prepare for webbing.





Flip the center column RST (right sides together) onto the first column. Chain sew them together but do not cut the threads between them. Press towards the twosies.

Repeat with the final column. Again, pressing towards the twosies.









Sew your rows together carefully matching seams and press each towards the twosies
