Cutting: Techniques:

| Fabric | Measurements Method 2 |
|---------|-----------------------|
| Color 1 | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |
| Color 8 | 8 @ 2 x 2 |
| | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |
| Color 9 | 4 @ 2 x 3 ½ |
| | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |

Stitch and Flip Flying Geese & HST 4 at a time

| Fabric | Measurements Method 3 |
|---------|-----------------------|
| Color 1 | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |
| Color 8 | 4 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 |
| | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |
| Color 9 | 1 @ 4 ½ x 4 ¼ |
| | 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½ |

No Waste Flying Geese 4 at a time AND HST

Make your flying geese using the method you prefer. You will need 4 geese using Color 8 and Color 9. Refer to the Quick Flying Geese handout for instructions if needed.

You will also need 4 HST with Color 1 and Color 8. The cutting instructions are for "4 at a time HST". As always, feel free to use the method of your choice to make them. Refer to previous handouts for cutting instructions. Trim to 2".

Lay out the block as shown. Just for fun, turn the HST so that color 8 is in the center. Decide which way you like best and web your block together. Press away from the geese units throughout.



Add the sashing and you are done.
