Block 12

Cutting:

Choose which method you want to use for making your Flying Geese!

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements – Method 2</i>
Color 2	4 @ 2 x 3 1/2 Geese
Color 7	8 @ 2 x 2 Geese 1 @ 2 5/8 x 2 5/8 - Square in Square 2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 - HST
Color 10	2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 cut diagonally 2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 - HST

Techniques:

Stitch and Flip
Flying Geese
Square in a Square
HST

OR

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements – Method 3</i>
Color 2	1 @ 4 1/4 x 4 1/4 Geese
Color 7	6 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 4-Geese 2-HST 1 @ 2 5/8 x 2 5/8 Square in Square
Color 10	2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 cut diagonally 2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8 - HST

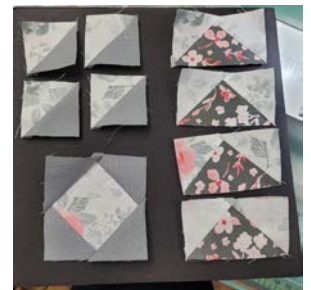
No Waste

Sewing:

We are going to revisit a few different techniques on this block.

You will need:

- 4 Flying Geese - Make your flying geese using the method you prefer.
- 4 HST - Because these are outside corners I made them 2 at a time.
Trim to 2"
- 1 Square in a Square - Refer to Week 1 - Block 24 for a refresher.
Trim to 3 1/2"



After you have all your components it is time to construct the block.



Lay out your pieces as shown and web them together. Press towards the geese units. Add sashing and you are done.
