### Block 49

#### Cutting:

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 1	4 @ 2 x 2
Color 5	4 @ 2 x 3 ½
Color 6	4 @ 2 x 2 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½
Color 8	4 @ 2 x 2 1 @ 3 ½ x 3 ½

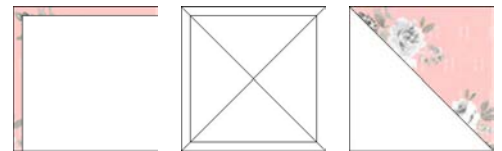
#### Techniques:

Stitch and Flip  
Parallelogram

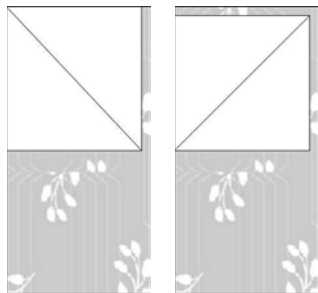
HST 4 at a time

#### Sewing:

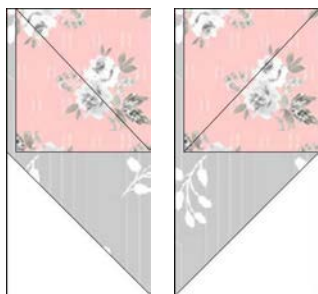
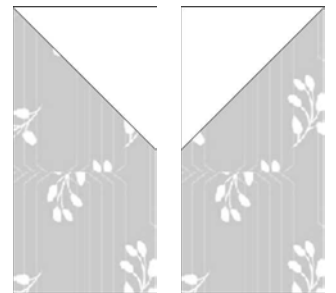
Let's start easy again. HST 4 at a time! Using the 3 ½ squares, layer Color 8 RST with Color 6 and sew all the way around. Cut twice diagonally. Press toward color 6 and trim to 2".



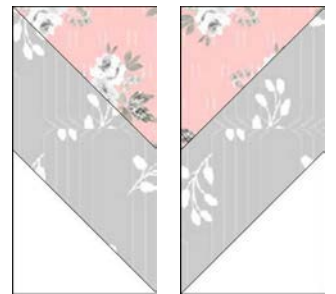
More Parallelograms! This time we need to be extra careful with color placement as they are not all the same!



Begin by drawing a line diagonally on all of the 2" squares. Using Color 8 with the Color 5 rectangles, layer 2 of the squares with your line going from the top left corner to the bottom right and two going from the top right to the bottom left. This is your sewing line. Sew one thread to the outside of the line. Press toward color 5, trim the back two pieces.

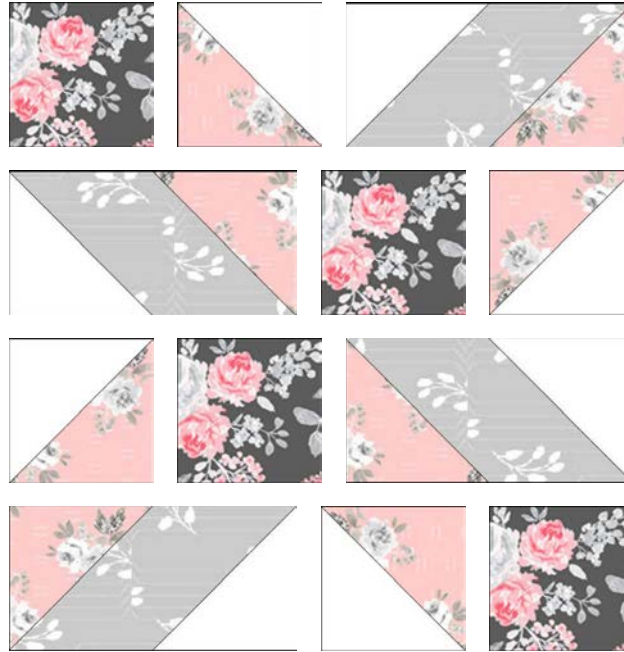


Repeat the process with Color 6 square. Layer your marked square with the other end of the rectangle, so the line goes in the same direction as the first square. Sew then press towards color 6.



Time to build!

This one is kinda tricky. Take your time and make sure you are referencing the sample block for placement. You can sew into quadrants or in rows; the results will be the same. Press towards Color 1 when you can. When placed correctly, color 6 will make a secondary parallelogram.
