### **Cutting:**

#### **Techniques:**

Choose which method you want to use for making your Flying Geese!

Fabric	Measurements – Method 2
Color 3	8 @ 2 x 2
Color 6	4 @ 2 x 2
	$1 @ 2 x 4 \frac{1}{2}$
Color 9	4 @ 2 x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>
Color 10	$1 @ 2 x 4 \frac{1}{2}$

Stitch and Flip Flying Geese

OR

Fabric	Measurements – Method 3
Color 3	$4 @ 2\frac{3}{8} \times 2\frac{3}{8}$
Color 6	4 @ 2 x 2
	$1 @ 2 x 4 \frac{1}{2}$
Color 9	1 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼
Color 10	$1 @ 2 x 4 \frac{1}{2}$

No Waste Flying Geese 4 at a time

#### Sewing:

Make 4 flying geese with Color 3 and Color 9, using the method you prefer. (I used the Stitch and Flip Method in the video)



#### Let's built the center block.



Layer Color 6 and Color 10 2 x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> rectangles RST and sew on the lengthwise side. Press towards Color 10. Cut into 2 pieces 2 x 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.

Layer RST together alternating the colors and nesting the center seam and sew. This will measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ 



Time to layout and web. Press towards the center square so that the bulk at the goose point is dispersed and not doubled.
