

## Whitlock's Weekly Whimsy Week 13

Block 5

## Cutting:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 2 | 4 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 6 | 8 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 7 | 4 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 10 | 4 @ $2 \times 31 / 2$ |
| Color 11 | 4 @ $2 \times 31 / 2$ |

## Techniques:

Flying Geese
Parallelograms

## Sewing:

This block looks way more complicated than it is!
All you need are 4 geese units and 4 parallelogram units. You have this!
Begin by drawing a diagonal line on all of the 2 " squares.
We are going to build both units at the same time. You will need both color rectangles. Position Color 10 horizontally and Color 11 vertically, as shown below

Geese
Place Color 6 squares RST on the rectangles with the drawn line going from the Top Right to the Bottom Left. Sew just outside the line. Pressing: the Goose unit press towards Color 6 and the parallelogram towards Color 11. Trim the back two layers.

Adding the second triangle:
For the goose unit add Color 2 with the drawn line running from Top Left to Bottom Right. Press towards Color 2.


For the parallelogram add Color 7 with the drawn line going Top Right to Bottom Left. Press towards Color 7

Build your quadrants (they are all the same). Press towards the parallelogram units. Notice the two Color 6 corners are forming an extra Goose unit! Make 4

Sew the quadrants together to form your block. Spin the center seam.
