## Block 68

## Cutting:

## Techniques:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 1 | $1 @ 2 \times 161 / 2$ |
| Color 12 | $1 @ 2 \times 161 / 2$ |

Strips

OR
16 @ $2 \times 2$ of as many colors as you want. (You could use 8 colored and 8 background.)

## Sewing:

## Using Strips:

- Sew Color 1 and Color 2 together lengthwise. Press towards

- Fold in half and cut into two pieces $31 / 2 \times 81 / 4$
- Layer strips RST alternating the colors so that you can nest the seams.
- Sub cut into $2 \times 31 / 2$ strips. These pieces will be stacked and ready to sew into a 4 -patch unit.

- Spin seams and press. Make 4


## Using 2" squares:

- If you are using 8 background and 8 colors, begin by sewing one of each together. Press towards the color.
- Lay out your units in a pleasing arrangement and sew them into 4-patch units.
- Spin seams and press. Make 4

Now build your block with the four units. You will be able to spin
 all the seams. The back will look awesome!
