## Cutting:

## Techniques:

HST

## Sewing:

Just like block 35, let's begin with the HSTs. Draw a diagonal line on the uncut color 8 blocks. Layer with color 2 and sew on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press towards color 2 and trim to 2 ".

At this point I laid out all the pieces of my block so that I could make sure of the placement before I began making quadrants and pieced corners. Because I like to chain piece, I began sewing at the top right and sewed the first of the triangles onto Color 8 for the pieced corner, then down to the bottom left and did that one too!

Without cutting the thread, I then jump to the top left HST and sew to its Color 8 square, then the one below it, I skipped over to the lower right quadrant and did the same thing.

This is when I reached behind my needle and retrieved the pieced corners, pressed towards Color 2, trimmed dog ears and added the second triangle.

Without cutting threads, I again reached behind and retrieved the HST quadrants and finished piecing them.

One more time I retrieved the pieced corners, pressed towards color 2, trimmed the dog ears and finished by adding Color 6 triangles. Time to cut all the threads! Press towards Color 6.

You will have made all four quadrants, so now build your block!
