## Cutting:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 1 | 1 @ $41 / 4 \times 41 / 4$ |
| Color 7 | 4 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 8 | 4 @ $2 \times 2$ |
|  | $4 @, 2^{3 / 3} \times 23 / 8$ |
| Color 11 | $4 @ 2 \times 31 / 2$ |

## Block Breakdown:

This is another block that can be made in many different ways. You could make the entire block with 16 HST's. That just seems like extra work to me, so I went with Geese and Parallelograms.

By using these two units I was able to make four identical quadrants, which I love!

## Techniques:

Flying Geese
Stitch and Flip
Parallelograms



## Sewing:

Make four Geese units with Color 1 and Color 8 using the method of your choice. Press all seams towards Color 8.


Make four Parallelograms with Color 11 as the base and Color 7 and Color 8 at the corners. Press towards Color 7 and Color 8.


Sew the Geese unit and Parallelogram unit together to make each quadrant. Make 4

Lay out following the diagram and sew together. Spin the center seam
