

# Whitlock's Weekly Whimsy Week 21 

## Block 37

## Cutting:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 2 | 4 @ $2 \times 5$ |
| Color 5 | 1 @ $2 \times 41 / 2$ |
| Color 8 | 8 @ $2 \times 2$ |
| Color 12 | 1 @ $2 \times 41 / 2$ |

## Block Breakdown:

So many options with this block! You could make 4 Geese and use 2" squares. There would be seams in the Color 2 areas. As always, you could make this one with a bunch of HST's, again resulting in a couple of seams in the Color 2 areas.

I chose to go with an elongated Parallelogram for this one. I strip quilted the center 4 patch and used a partial seam to attach all the parallelograms. Be sure to watch the videos for more details and to see how to make a partial seam.

## Sewing:

Using the strip quilting method, sew your center 4-patch.

Make 4 identical parallelograms with the diagonal going from the top right corner to the bottom left corner. Press the first towards color 8 and the second towards color 2. Both seams will be going in the same direction.


Layout your units following the diagram. You will need to sew a partial seam when you begin the first parallelogram. Layer right sides together matching the bottom left corner or the 4 patch with the top left corner of parallelogram \#1. Begin at the corner and sew about half way. Leave the rest un-sewn for now. Press towards the center block.
You will now be able to align the whole length of parallelogram \#2 to the block. Work clockwise, pressing towards the center. Once you have all four attached, you can finish the partial seam on the bottom.

Congratulations, you did it!
