Square in a Square

Snowball Corners

Block Breakdown:

Holy Moley! That is a lot of HSTs! Let's see if we can simplify this a little. What if we look at it like a Square in a Square? Do you see them? If we start with a solid block in the center and add 3 rounds of triangles we would almost have it. The only thing missing would be the outside corner squares. That is an easy fix with the Snowball Corner technique.



Sewing:

Begin with the color 8 square ($2 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$). Use the Square in a Square technique to add color 6 triangles. Press towards color 6. Trim to $3 \frac{1}{2}$




Now use the color 8 triangles to make another round of Square in a Square. Again, press outward towards color 8. This should measure 4 3/4.



One more round. Add Color 3. Press towards color 3.





The final step is to add the Color 8 corners. We will use the same technique you use to make parallelograms. Draw a diagonal line on the color 8 squares. Layer RST with the Color 3. Sew on the line. Press towards color 8. Trim away the back two layers.
