## Block 34

## Cutting:

## Techniques:

| Fabric | Measurements |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 1 \& Color 12 | 1 @ $4 \times 4$ |
| Color 7 \& Color 11 | $1 @ 2 \times 81 / 2$ |

## Block Breakdown:

You have been working hard, so let's have an easy one this week. The only decision to make on this one is whether to use 2" squares to make your 4-patch units or strip quilt them! If you are making the scrappy version, you might want to cut squares; otherwise strip quilting is just a bit faster.


## Sewing:

We will begin with the HST. Use the 4 " squares to make these. Press towards Color 1 . Trim to $31 / 2$.


Next are the 4-patches. If you are strip quilting, layer the $81 / 2$ strips RST and sew the long edge. Press toward Color 11.

Fold this in half lengthwise and cut in half. You now have two pieces that are $31 / 2 \times 41 / 4$. Layer RST nesting the seam. Cut into $2 \times 31 / 2$ strips. Sew. Spin the center seam when pressing.


You have everything you need to build your block! Easy Peasy!
Sew into pairs and press towards the 4-patch unit.
