Color 8	$1 @ 2 x 8 \frac{1}{2}$

Block Breakdown:

You deserve another easy block! Not much happening with this one. If you are doing scrappy, you may want to cut your Color 3 and Color 8 blocks individually. You will need four of each color way. Otherwise, we will practice the Strip Quilting technique one more time.

Sewing:

Begin by sewing Color 3 and Color 8 together lengthwise. Press towards Color 3.

Fold in half lengthwise and cut in half. You will now have two pieces $3\frac{1}{2} \ge 4\frac{1}{4}$.

Layer these pieces RST alternating the colors. Cut into 2 @ 2 x 3 ¹/₂. You now have them ready to sew. Make sure your seams are nested nicely and sew. Spin the center seams.

Build the block. Press towards Color 1.

Spin the center seam.
