### Block 21

#### Cutting:

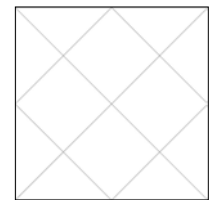
<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 10 & Color 11	1 @ 4 1/4 x 4 1/4
Color 3 & Color 6	2 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8

#### Techniques:

HST  
Square in a Square  
4-Patch

#### Block Breakdown:

Another pretty simple block. You will need a 4-patch for the center and some triangles for the corners. If I was making more than one block, I would cut 2 3/8 strips for the 4-patch units and use the strip sewing method to make multiples. However, we just need one, so cutting squares makes sense. The corners are made from a HST. We can use a HST because we need the colors to be in opposite corners.



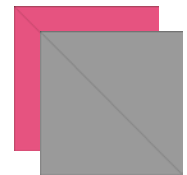
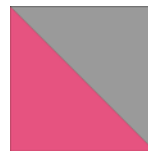
#### Sewing:

Begin by making the 4-patch using Colors 3 and 6. Easy Peasy!

For the corner units, layer Colors 10 and 11 RST and draw a line diagonally. Sew a 1/4" seam on each side of the line. When you cut and press them (towards the dark) you will have two HST.



Cut these in half diagonally across the seam.



Now you have four pieced corner units.  
Two of each color placement.

Time to build!
