

SUPPLY LIST FOR THE DECORATIVE TOWEL BAND

- Towel: heavy cotton or linen fabric. The project uses a towel approximately 19" x 27"
- Towel Band: Fabric 6 ½" wide x length of towel short edge plus 2." Band will be folded in half for a completed 3" band.
- A sewing machine
- 80/12 sewing machine needle for construction
- 90/14 sewing machine needle for topstitching
- An iron
- Tear-away stabilizer approximately 3" wide and length of towel band
- Measuring tape or a ruler
- Marking pencil: washout or disappearing
- Optional: Hand sewing needle
- All Purpose thread to match towel fabric
- Decorative thread to contrast with band fabric

TIP: You can use any purchased towel. I suggest you remove the hem from the end, where you will sew the towel band to help eliminate bulk. I used a linen towel purchased at Craft Warehouse and cut the towel half across the width for the sample towel in the video. The hem would need to be sewn on one side only, and you can make two towels.

These towels are approximately 28" x 18", and when cut in half, your towel will be about 14" x 18" before the side hem.
