

You now have all of the blocks for the center of the quilt, and all of your border blocks, too. Quilt will not be completed in class. Finished size is 72" This class is not for beginners. Some piecing experience is necessary.

Ho, Ho, Ho. Just in time for Christmas, the quilt that looks harder than it is. Just don't tell anyone how easily it goes together if you want to stay on Santa's Good List.

Learn how to use the Omnigrid 96L and the Omnigrid 98L to cut half-square and quarter square triangles. These rulers make for accurate piecing of triangles and who can't use the help. If you chose to use a motif for the center of the star block, Santa left a trick or two from his workshop to help.

It is the perfect quilt to use up bits and pieces from your stash for a scrappier look. Alternatively, if you prefer, grab those fat quarters you have been collecting.







CLASS AND EVENTS POLICY

We are here to help you have a great experience.

REGISTRATION: It is necessary to pre-register for classes and events. Payment is due at time of registration and assures a seat in the class or event. Payment accepted in the store or over the phone by credit card.

REFUND: For Machine Mastery and Software Level Classes, we will refund a class fee up to five(5) days prior to the date of the class or transfer the fee to another date that the class is offered. For classes other than Machines Mastery and Software Level Classes, you need to cancel five (5) days prior to class to receive a refund. After 5 days, we cannot refund your registration; however, you may sit in a class taught by the same teacher. Refunds are not applicable to events.

CANCELLATION: From time to time, it may be necessary to cancel a class. Registration fee promptly refunded when a class cancels.

WAIT LIST: Placement on a wait list when class is full does not require payment in advance. Payment is due at the time a seat becomes available.

PARKING

PARKING OPTIONS:

Parking is available at the Chemeketa Parkade.

Parking on the street is for three hours. After three hours, it is necessary to move vehicle to another block.

There is a paid parking lot behind the store at the end of the alley or off Chemeketa.

Drop off your machine and supplies prior to parking by pulling into the alley next to the store. Please make sure not to block the sidewalk.

CLASS PRICING MACHINE MASTERY and SOFTWARE CLASSES

A Machine Mastery Class cost is \$15.00 per Level for machines purchased at Whitlocks. Cost includes a \$5.00 coupon usable for notions on day of class. The cost is \$50.00 for machines not purchased and sold at Whitlocks.

Level Classes are included with purchase of the Machine Assurance Program (M.A.P.) and includes 15% off all notions.

Customers who purchase their software at Whitlock's qualify for Whitlock's Software Mastery Level Classes. The class fee is \$15 per Level. Cost includes a \$5.00 coupon usable for notions on day of class. The cost is \$50.00 for software not purchased and sold at Whitlocks.
