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Pattern Basics

We encourage breaking the rules, but here are a few things you might want to keep in mind:

- Please read through all the instructions carefully before beginning a project. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern.
- All instructions use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
- All fabrics are sewn right sides together, unless otherwise stated.

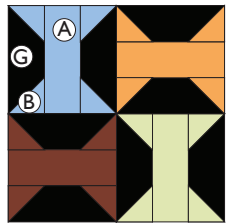
Common Quilting Acronyms:

FQ = fat quarter (18" x 22")	WS = wrong side of fabric
FE = fat eighth (18" x 11")	RS = right side of fabric
WOFQ = width of fat quarter	HST = half square triangle
WOF = width of fabric	QST = quarter square triangle

Spool Blocks:

- On the WS draw a diagonal line through all Bs. With four Bs of the same fabric, layer one B and G together. Stitch slightly to the outside of the drawn line and cut leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press.

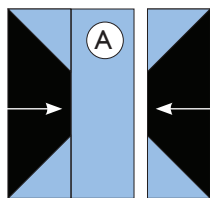


Follow the same process as shown below for the opposite side of G with another B. Press.



Make 2
2-1/2" x 6-1/2"

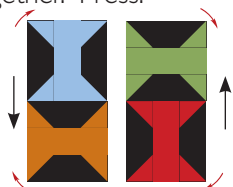
- Sew a B/G unit to each side of an A from the same fabric. Press.



6-1/2" square

- Sew 80 Spool Blocks following Steps 1 - 2.

- Sew two sets of different spools together turning each spool clockwise 90° once. Press. Sew the two units together. Press.

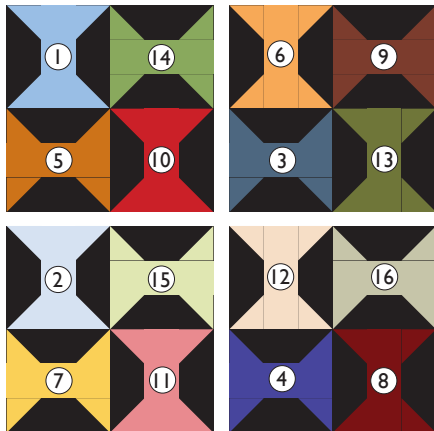


6-1/2" x 12-1/2"



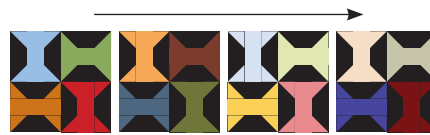
Make 20
12-1/2" square

Make five of each combination block. The number represents fabric assignment.



Constructing the top:

- Sew Spool Blocks together into five rows of four blocks each. Mix and turn blocks for a random look. Press.

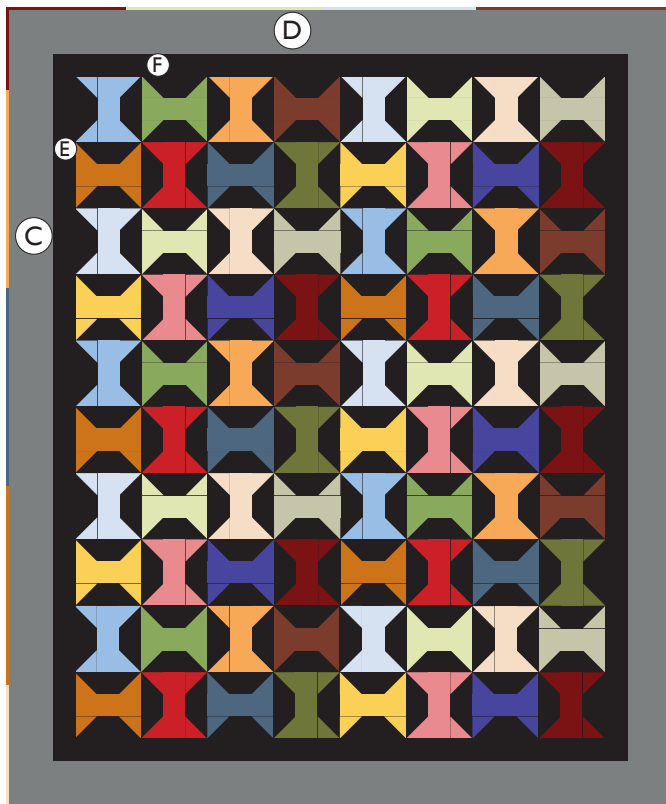


- Sew E to each side of the interior body of the quilt. Sew an F to the top and bottom. Press all seams toward the borders.



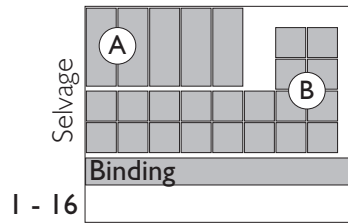
Note: Measure through the center both vertically and horizontally for accurate border measurements.

Sew C to the sides of the quilt. Sew D to the top and bottom. Press all seams toward the borders.

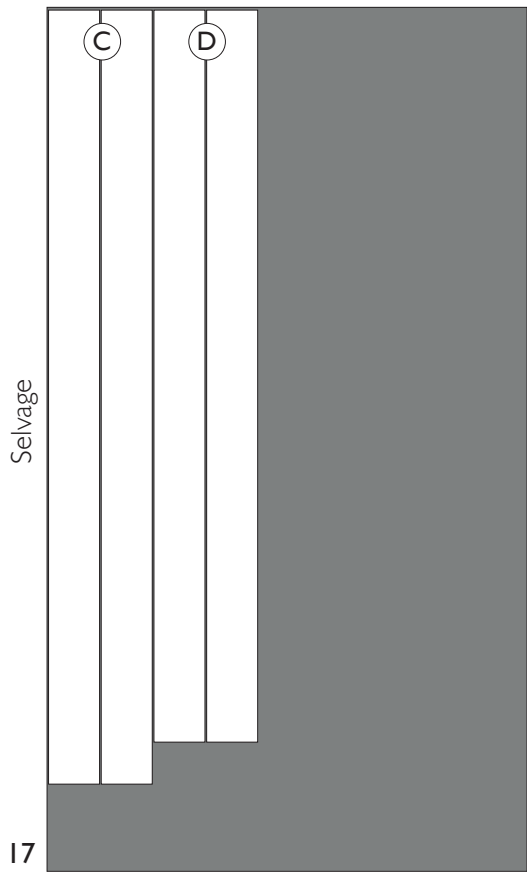


- Sew all binding strips from each FQ together. Press seams open. Layer backing RS down, batting and top RS up. Quilt. Bind with a 1/4" seam allowance.

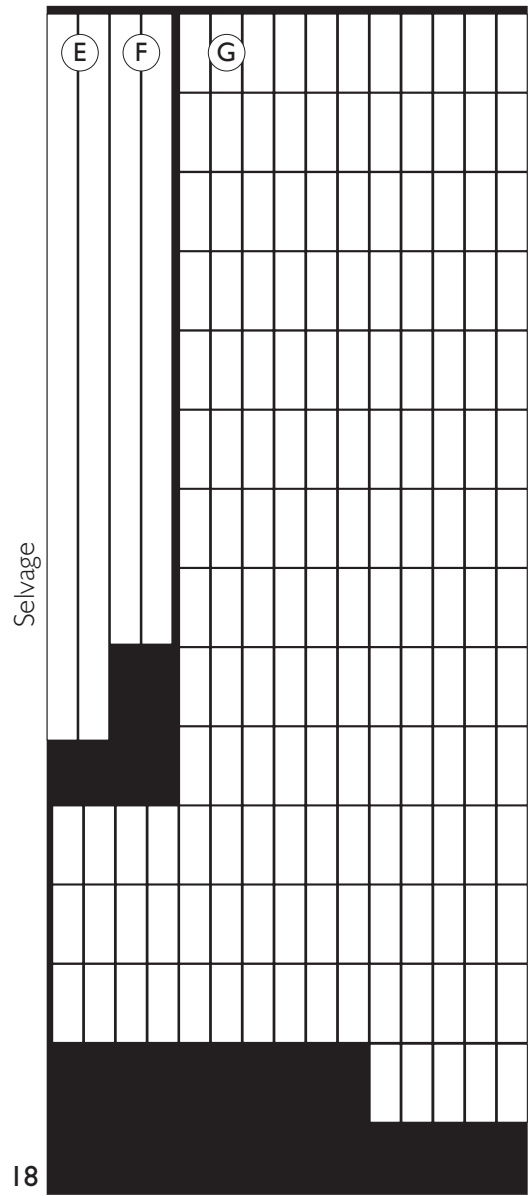
