Backing: 5-1/2 yds. needed for a two piece backing.

DIRECTIONS:

1. To make the flying geese blocks: Placing right sides together, sew two K squares to an H rectangle, sewing the K squares on one at a time. Sew on the marked lines, and trim to a 1/4" seam allowance, as shown in diagram. Repeat 5. Sew the rows from steps for all. Make 80.








2. Sew each K/H unit to an F rectangle as shown. Make 80, each measuring 4-1/2" square.



Make 80 4-1/2" square



3. Sew a G square to each side of a K/H/F. Make 40 units.







4. Sew the remaining K/H/F units to the sides of each C square, making sure that the white H triangles are next to C. Make 20 units.





3 and 4 together as shown to make the block. Make 20, each measuring 12-1/2" square.





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
6. Sew the **D** sashing strips to the sides of the blocks as shown. Make 5 rows, each with 4 blocks and 5 **D** strips.




7. Sew four **D** strips and five **E** squares together as shown to make the sashing strips that will be sewn between each row



8. Sew the quilt block rows and the sashing rows together as shown below to make the quilt top.




- 9. Sew the pieced **J** strips to the sides of the quilt, and then sew the **I** strips to the top and bottom.
- 10. Sew the **B** borders to the sides of the quilt, and then sew the **A** borders to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.



11. Quilt as desired and bind using a 3/8" seam allowance.
