

## Rainbow Heart Block

Skill Level BEGINNER

Finished Block Size
$12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

Note: Templates $A$ and $B$ are printed without seam allowance.

Cutting Instructions
(cut in order listed)
Black solid
1 square $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Assorted red prints
cut 1 matched set of:
2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
cut a total of:
8 Template B
Orange mottle
1 Template A

## Making the Block

Referring to Diagram I, sew 2 matching red $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides of black solid $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew matching $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to top and bottom to make framed square.

Diagram I


2 Finger press framed square in half on length, width, and both diagonals; use folds as placement guide. Referring to Diagram II, position orange A in center of square as shown. Arrange red Bs around orange A so that hearts just touch one another. Appliqué all in place.


Diagram II
