

## Whirligig Garden Block

Skill Level

## Finished Block Size

$16^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$
Note: Appliqué templates are given reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)
White
2 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2 rectangles $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
8 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Dark green
4 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Light green
4 squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
4 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 assorted brights-cut from each:

1 Template A
Light yellow
4 Template B

## Other Materials

1/4 yd. paper-backed fusible web 4 assorted bright buttons, $3 / 8-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (optional)

## Sew

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram I, place marked square on dark green $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 8 . In same manner, make 8 pieced squares using light green and white $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


2 Place light green $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip on light green/white pieced square, right sides together, aligning raw edges (Diagram II). Sew together using $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Open and press to complete stem square. Make 4.


3 Referring to Diagram III, sew 4 rows using 8 dark green/ white pieced squares, 4 stem squares, and 4 light green/ white pieced squares. Sew rows together to make 1 large pieced square.

4 Sew white $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to sides of large pieced square (Diagram IV). Sew white $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips to top and bottom.


5 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-B on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.

6 Finger-press pieced square in half on both length and width; use folds as placement guides. Position A and B shapes in alphabetical order (Diagram V). Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch (Diagram VI). Optional: Tack a button to center of each flower.
