

Whirligig Garden Block

Skill Level **CONFIDENT BEGINNER**

Finished Block Size 16" x 16"

Note: Appliqué templates are given reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)
White

- 2 strips 41/2" x 161/2"
- 2 rectangles 41/2" x 81/2"
- 8 squares 27/8" x 27/8" Dark green
- 4 squares 27/8" x 27/8" Light green
 - 4 squares 21/8" x 27/8"
 - 4 strips 1" x 21/2"
- 4 assorted brights—cut from each:
- 1 Template A Light yellow
 - 4 Template B

Other Materials

1/4 yd. paper-backed fusible web 4 assorted bright buttons, 3/8-5/8" (optional)

Sew


1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white 27/8" square. Referring to **Diagram I**, place marked square on dark green 27/8" square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 8. In same manner, make 8 pieced squares using light green and white 27/8" squares.












2 Place light green 1" x 2½" strip on light green/white pieced square, right sides together, aligning raw edges (Diagram II). Sew together using ½" seam allowance.

Trim seam allowance to ¼". Open and press to complete stem square. Make 4.




3 Referring to **Diagram III**, sew 4 rows using 8 dark green/white pieced squares, 4 stem squares, and 4 light green/white pieced squares. Sew rows together to make 1 large pieced square.








4 Sew white 8½" rectangles to sides of large pieced square (**Diagram IV**). Sew white 16½" strips to top and bottom.





5 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-B on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.



6 Finger-press pieced square in half on both length and width; use folds as placement guides. Position A and B shapes in alphabetical order (Diagram V). Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch (Diagram VI). Optional: Tack a button to center of each flower.
