

Web Bonus: Tulip Twist

Finished Quilt Size
49" x 72½"

Note: Appliqué templates are printed re-versed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Plan

Cheerful greens and yellows from the Basically Patrick collection by RJR Fabrics are the perfect choice for this delightful lap quilt. Arrange tulips on one of the vertical strips to your liking and fuse in place. Then, place the first strip underneath subsequent strips for an easy placement guide and to ensure that all rows of tulips line up neatly across the quilt.

Shop

Dark green texture (stems, pieced strips, binding)	1 ⅛ yds.
Medium green texture (leaves, pieced strips)	5/8 yd.
Light green texture (leaves, pieced strips)	5/8 yd.
White mottle (background)	2 ⅛ yds.
Yellow texture (tulips)	¼ yd.
Light yellow mottle (tulips)	½ yd.
*Backing (piece widthwise)	3 ½ yds.
Batting size	58" x 82"
Fusible web	2 ⅛ yds.

*Yardage based on fabric with at least 42" of usable width.



Cut

(in order listed, before cutting appliqué)

Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates in the **Pattern Section**.

Dark green texture
7 strips 2½" x width of fabric (WOF) for binding
5 strips 2" x WOF

Medium green texture
5 strips 2" x WOF
Light green texture
5 strips 2" x WOF
White mottle
*4 strips 10" x 72½" cut on lengthwise grain
*Strips are cut to exact length.

Sew

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, sew together 1 each dark green texture, medium green texture, and light green texture WOF strips to make strip set. Make 5. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 48 segments 4" wide.

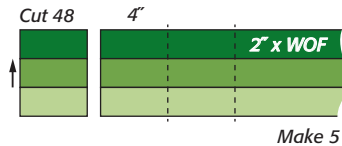
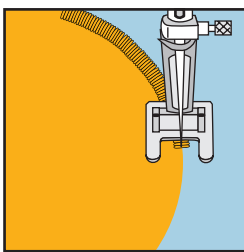

2 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A-E on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.

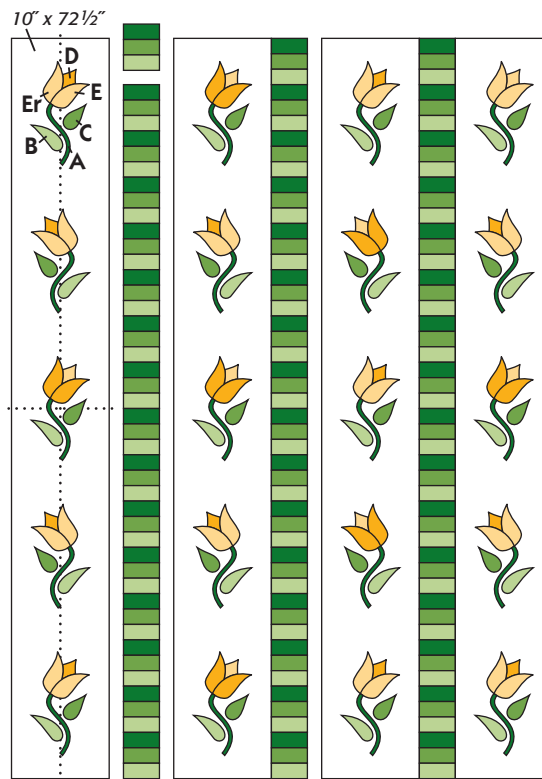
3 **Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** and **quilt photo** for following steps. Fold white mottle strip in half lengthwise and widthwise and finger press. Using folds as placement guides, position A-E/Er in alphabetical order as shown. Change order of adding E and Er, as desired. Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine satin stitch (**Diagram II**) to complete appliqué strip. Make 3 total.



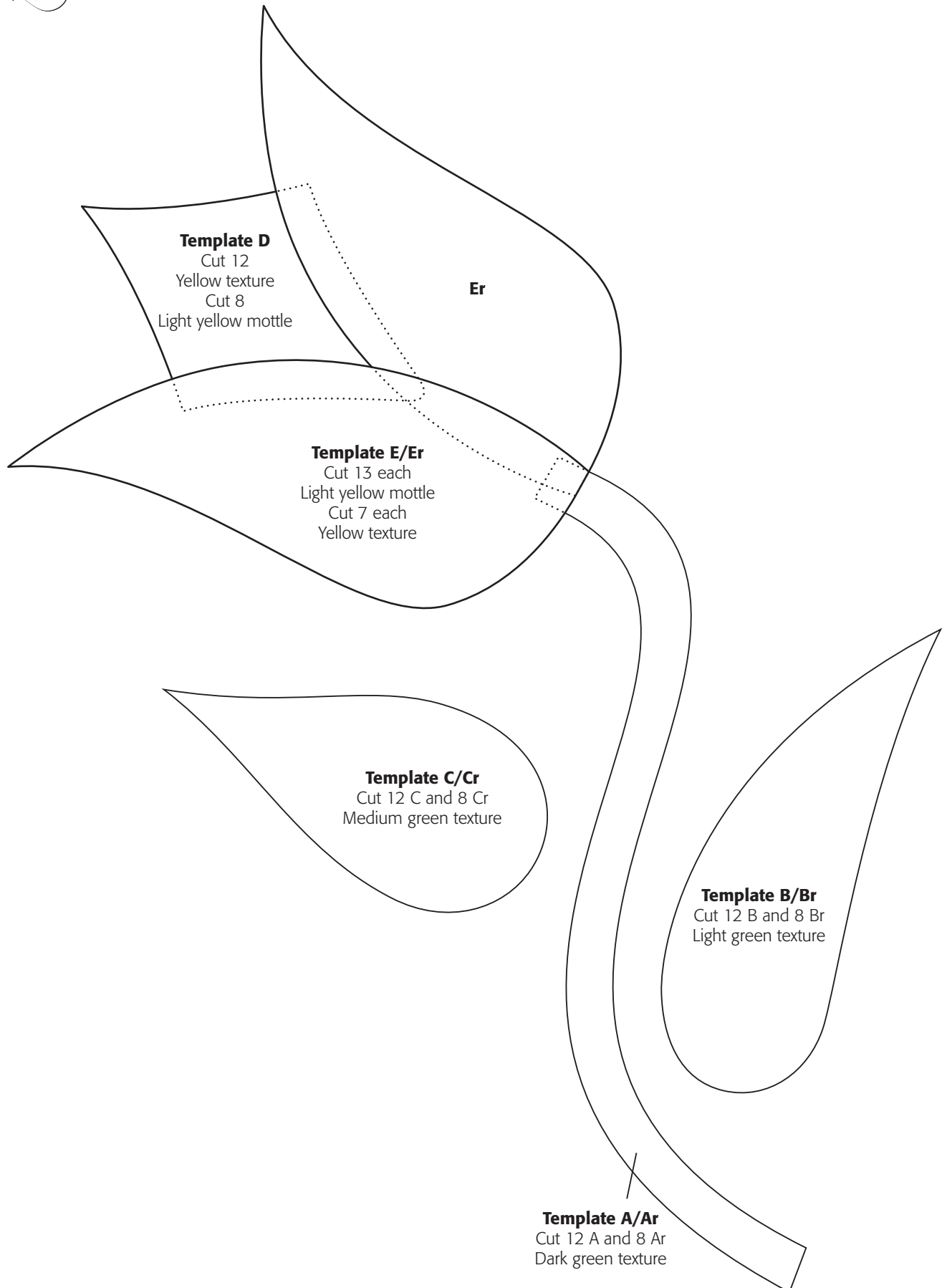
Satin stitch

- 4** Sew together 16 segments from Step 1 to make pieced strip. Make 3.
- 5** Sew appliqué strips and pieced strips together, alternating.
- 6** Layer, baste, and quilt. Laurie machine quilted feathered vines in the white background and a leafy vine in the pieced strips. Bind with dark green texture.

Dark green texture
