## EMBROIDERY

## Blue Tip

- Most Embroidery Threads
- Size 11

## Purple Tip

- Thicker Fabric
- Dense Stitch Embroidery
- Quilt Designs
- Size 14

## Red Tip

- Use with Metallic Threads
- Use with Thicker Fabrics
- Size 14

## NEEDLES

## Blue Tip

- The Blue Tip needle has a unique design with a pierce point plus a slightly long than normal scarf to cure skipped stitches and puckering in any problem fabric especially synthetics.

## Purple Tip

- Purple Tip Needles are designed to prevent skipped stitches with heavy fabrics, including knits, while doing sewing and embroidering. They feature a ball point tip to prevent fabric thread breakage and a special cobra shaped head to form a proper needle thread loop so that it prevents skipped stitches caused by the fluctuation of the fabric. And they're available in a heavier #14 size.

## Red Tip

- The large eye of the Red tip accommodates heavier threads, pampers delicate metallic threads that tend to shred and split, and makes needle threading easier.

## Blue Tip

- Fine Fabrics
  - Stretch, Tricot
  - Buttonholes
- Size Depending on Fabric Weight

## Purple Tip

- 9mm Wide Stitches
- Use to Avoid Skipped Stitches
- Use with Knits, Free Motion Quilting, Hems

## Red Tip

- All General Sewing
- Size Depends on Fabric Weight
