## Week 6

### Block 66

#### Cutting:

<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 1 and Color 10	2 @ 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 4 $\frac{3}{4}$
Color 5 and Color 12	1 @ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$

#### Techniques:

Magic 8  
HST 4 at a time

#### Sewing:

And one more Magic 8 with some HST 4-at-a-time thrown in for good measure.

Use color 1 and color 10 to make two sets of Magic 8. You will only need 12 HST but you can save the rest for something else. Press your seams towards color 1. Make sure you double check your sizing and trim to 2 x 2 if needed.

Use color 5 and color 12 to make HST 4 at a time. Refer Week 3 Block 65 for a refresher if necessary. Press towards color 12. Trim to 2 x 2. Remember, these will have bias edges so treat them carefully to prevent stretching.



Lay out your pieces on the design board. You will have a pinwheel in each quadrant, as well as a secondary pinwheel in the center of your block.

Sew into quadrants. Press and spin the center seam so the block lays flat.



When you sew the four quadrants together, you will be able to spin the center seam too!
