Block 62

Cutting:

Choose which method you want to use for making your Flying Geese!

| <i>Fabric</i> | <i>Measurements – Method 2</i> |
|---------------|--------------------------------|
| Color 1 | 4 @ 2 x 3 ½ |
| Color 6 | 4 @ 2 x 3 ½ |
| Color 8 | 16 @ 2 x 2 |

OR

| <i>Fabric</i> | <i>Measurements – Method 3</i> |
|---------------|--------------------------------|
| Color 1 | 1 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼ |
| Color 6 | 1 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼ |
| Color 8 | 8 @ 2 ⅜ x 2 ⅜ |

Techniques:

Stitch and Flip
Flying Geese

No Waste
Flying Geese
4 at a time

Sewing:

Make your flying geese using the method you prefer. You will need 4 geese using Color 1 and Color 8 and another 4 geese using Color 6 and Color 8.

After you have made your geese it is time to construct the block. You will be sewing Color 6 goose to the top of Color 1 goose units. Remember it easiest to sew with the goose on the top so that you can see where the point is and try to sew one thread above the point. Press towards Color 6 goose. Make four units. They will measure 3 ½ x 3 ½



These units will form a pinwheel in the center when you lay them out. Web the quadrants together. Spin the center seam.

Congratulations! Eighteen down...and you are officially a fourth of the way done!
