Cutting:

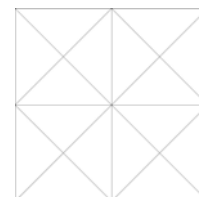
<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 2	1 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼
Color 10	2 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼
Color 11	1 @ 4 ¼ x 4 ¼

Techniques:

Quarter Square
Triangles

Block Breakdown:

Two good choices with this one. You could build a pinwheel for the center and add pieced corners using the Square in a Square technique. However, since we have become such masters of the Quarter Square Triangle, let's do that! We need four identical blocks.



Sewing:

This time we are using three colors in our QST units. The process is the same. Draw a diagonal line on both of the Color 10 blocks. Layer them RST with Color 2 and Color 11.



Sew ¼" on each side of the lines. Cut on the drawn line. Press towards Color 11. You will have two of each color-way.



Draw a line on the back of the Color 10/Color 11 units. Layer them right sides together with Color 2/Color 10 units being careful to nest the seams.

Cut on the drawn line.

Spin the center seam and press.

You will now have all four of the units necessary to build this block!

Use the Color 2 triangle to form the pinwheel. The center seam will be the final seam to spin. You will have one big pinwheel on the front and 5 little spun seams on the back! Too Cute!
