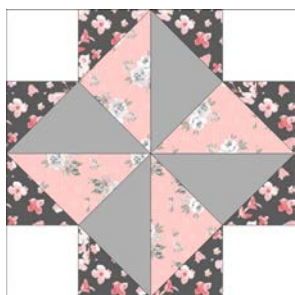

Cutting:

Color 2	4 @ 2 3/8 x 2 3/8
Color 6	2 @ 3 x 3
Color 8	4 @ 2 x 2
Color 10	2 @ 3 x 3

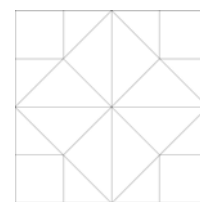
Techniques:

HST

Pieced
Corner

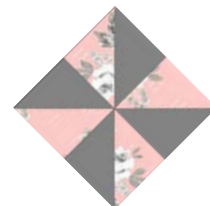
Block Breakdown:

The most obvious way to make this block is by making a HST pinwheel in the center and then some pieced corners added in the Square in a Square fashion. However you could also cut all pieces individually and sew your block into quadrants. I find this a bit more time consuming and give me more chance to make a mistake. So I will go with the pinwheel approach.



Sewing:

Let's begin by making the pinwheels. Use Color 6 and Color 10 to make four HST, Press towards Color 10 or your darkest color. Sew into a pinwheel. Spin center seam. Trim to 4 3/4"



Pieced Corners. Begin by cutting the Color 2 squares in half diagonally.

Use Color 8 square as the corner stone and sew two Color 2 triangles to make the unit.



Use the Square in a Square technique to add the pieced corners to your pinwheel.

Press toward the center pinwheel.
