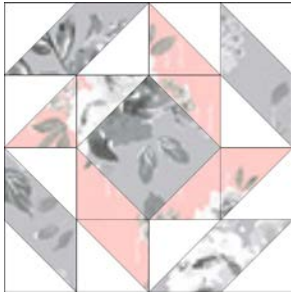


# Whitlock's Weekly Whimsy

## Week 31

### Block 42



#### Cutting:

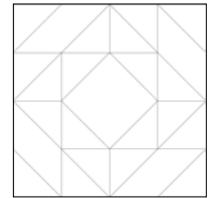
<i>Fabric</i>	<i>Measurements</i>
Color 4	1 @ 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> x 2 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> 4 @ 2 x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>
Color 6	2 @ 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> x 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> 1 @ 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>
Color 8	8 @ 2 x 2 1 @ 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> x 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>

#### Techniques:

- Square in a Square
- Parallelogram
- 4 @ a time HST
- Partial Seam

#### Block Breakdown:

This block takes us back to many of the techniques we have learned! We could use the same plan as we did for Block 4, but I didn't want the seams in the center of this one. So we are going to use the partial seam method and build in rows instead of quadrants.



#### Sewing:

First order of business is the Square in a Square for the center. Use the 2 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> Color 4 square for the center. Cut the 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> Color 6 squares once diagonally for the triangles. Add them to each side. Press towards color 6. Trim to 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>



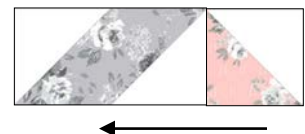
Use Color 4 and Color 8 to make your parallelograms. They are all the same so chain piece them and you will be done in no time. Press towards Color 4.



Finally use the 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> squares of Color 6 and Color 8 to make the four at a time HST. Press towards color 6. Trim to 2"



Sew the parallelograms and the HST triangles together to form one unit. Press towards the Parallelogram.



Begin building by sewing Unit 1 to the center unit from the circle to the point of the arrow. Leave the rest of the seam open. Add Unit 2, Unit 3 and Unit 4. Now go back to Unit 1 and finish the seam.
